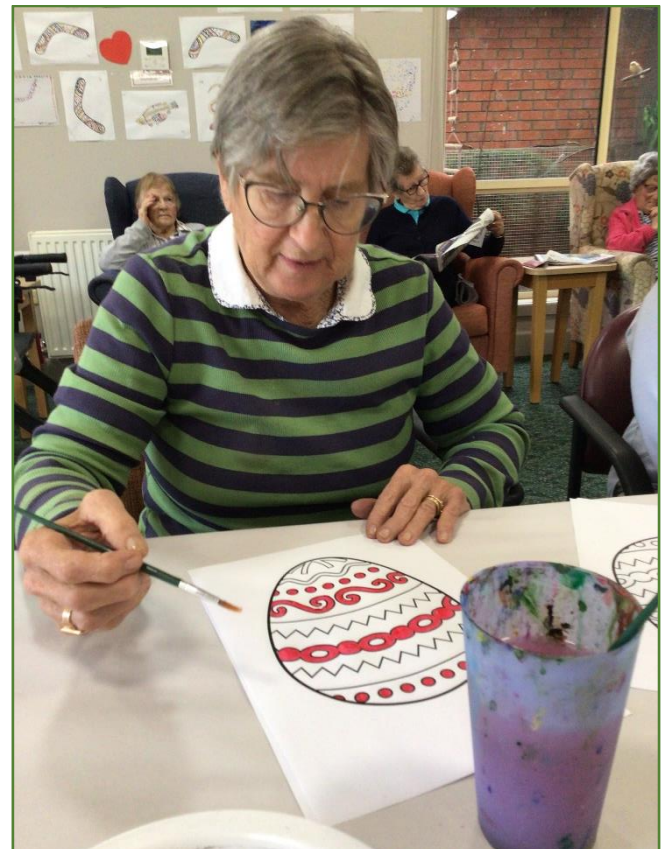
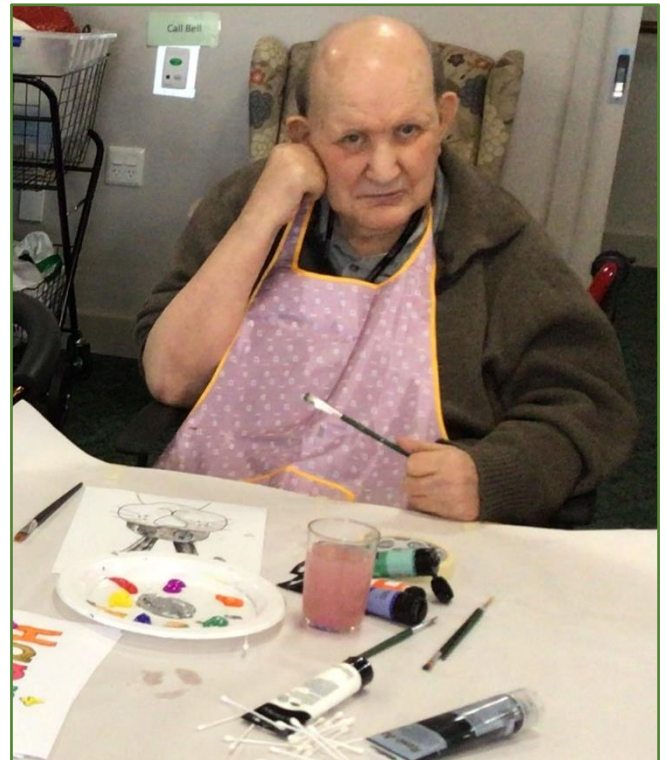


A huge thank you to the Brebner family and other staff who donated prizes for this raffle.
