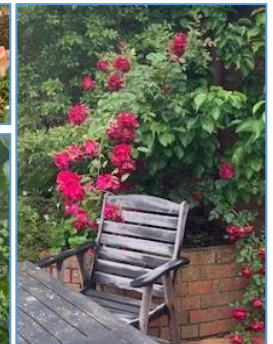
CARE MANAGER REPORT
